

Medical Technology Major Advising Check-List

There are two tracks to Medical Technology:

Plan I - A major in Medical Technology entails three years work at Augustana and one year of work at an approved school of medical technology. Augustana allows 40 hours for successful completion of the fourth year.

Plan II - Completion of a major in Chemistry or Biology followed by one year of clinical experience (identical to Plan I) and passage of the registry examination certifies the student as a registered technologist.
